Summary:

The aim of this event is to promote best practices exchange across the successful European Grant Offices and provide the experts' insight on cross-cutting issues.

The workshop is supported by the [TwinnToInfect](#) EU funded project under the Twinning action of the "Spreading Excellence and Widening Participation" H2020 Work Programme. TwinnToInfect provides the opportunity to IMM Lisboa to consolidate its research excellence in the immunity and infection scientific fields at the European level, by building a sustainable network with two internationally leading and recognised organisations – the Institut Pasteur (France) and the Francis Crick Institute (UK).

It is a Capacity Building Activity under the scope of TwinnToInfect, and as such, we are counting on the valuable support from our colleagues in the partner institutions. The first day of the workshop will be dedicated to knowledge exchange between peers (three Grant Offices within the consortium and three external ones), while the second day will bring five experts on cross-cutting issues: Proposal Preparation, Ethics, Open Science, Open Access and FAIR Data Management, Research impact and Collaborative programs with the US. During these two days, sufficient time will be allocated for networking and discussion. Particular sessions will be open to IMM researchers and research administration staff as well as to other relevant research institutions in Portugal.
